BUSINESS RULE

Membership Application Fee and Annual Membership Subscription



STATEMENT

A person is only eligible for appointment as Director of the Company if the person is an ordinary member.

Due process will be applied to ensure members have time to submit a 'show cause' for nonpayment of annual subscription.

OUTCOME

The annual membership subscription process will be delivered in a transparent and equitable manner.

EVALUATION

The subscription process will be reviewed annually in the third quarter of any financial year.

Membership Application fee

The fee payable for ACCYPN membership is such a sum as the ACCYPN Board Directors prescribe from time to time in respect of each class of membership and will be displayed on the ACCYPN website.

1. Annual Membership Subscription

- a) All annual subscriptions are due and payable by 1 July each year,
- b) Invoices to current members will be sent out on 1st May of each calender year,
- c) Payment after the 31st July will incur an application/administration fee.

2. Unpaid annual subscriptions

- a) A member ceases to be entitled to any of the rights or privileges of membership if the annual subscription of a member remains unpaid for one month after it becomes payable (31st July),
- b) A notice of default is given to the member pursuant to a resolution of the ACCYPN Directors. However, the rights or privileges of membership may be reinstated on payment of all arrears (including administration fee) if the Directors think fit to do so.

3. Removal and cessation of Membership

Resignation

3rd October

- a) A member may resign from the ACCYPN by giving written notice to the Secretary,
- b) The resignation of a member is deemed to take effect from the date of receipt of the notice of resignation or a later date as is provided in the notice.

Failure to Pay and removal of membership— (to be read in conjunction with the ACCYPN Constitution).

2 nd July	If membership has not been paid, the member is sent a
	letter and asked their intent to remain a member or not. A
	member is given one month to respond.
2nd August	

2 nd August	If a member has failed to respond to notice of July 2^{nd} and
	the annual subscription remains unpaid then a member
	ceases to be entitled to any rights and privileges of
	membership.

3rd August	A member is issued a show cause letter as to why they
	should not be removed from the register. The member has
	two months to respond.

If a member has not shown cause, the ACCYPN Directors
may consider their removal from the membership record.
An ordinary resolution of members is required to pass the
necessary resolution to remove a member from the register.
Removal from the record becomes effective on the 31st
December.
