According to the Constitution of the Australian College of Children and Young People's Nurses (ACCYPN), prior to the Annual General Meeting, a Call for Board Nominations is required to be sent to all Ordinary members.

At each Annual General Meeting there is one position vacant for one (1) Board member from each State/Territory. All nominations are for a period of 2 - 3 years (ref. section 9.9 ACCYPN Constitution). You are invited to submit an application for a Director position on the ACCYPN Board.

This is a very exciting time for the ACCYPN with the development of the Standards of Practice, Credentialing project and also new Position Statements being developed. Becoming a Director on the ACCYPN Board of Directors is a great opportunity.

Applications close 5.00pm Thursday 15 October 2015.

Nominees must send the following with their application:

- Completed Nomination Form
- Curriculum Vitae
- A biography of 150 - 300 words to outline your qualifications/experience. This will be sent to members if there is a vote required.

Should there be more than one nominee from any State/Territory, ballot papers will be forwarded to members residing in that State/Territory to vote for a Director to represent their State/Territory.

The newly elected Director positions will take effect once notification of appointment is received from the Board following the AGM to be held on Monday 30 November 2015 at 7pm (AEST).
