Dr. Curley has led teams in developing evidence-based procedures for identifying patients at risk for pressure ulcers, evaluated the effects of prone positioning in children treated for acute respiratory distress and lung injury, and helped to develop nutrition guidelines for patients on mechanical ventilation. Her research also focuses on interventional studies to support parent needs and priorities in the PICU, instrument development studies to provide clinicians with better tools to assess patient status and risk, and multi-site clinical trials to generate new knowledge in the care of critically-ill paediatric patients.
